Would you like to help our church earn money? **KROGER** gives our church money each quarter for you shopping there.

Any transactions moving forward using the Shopper's Card number associated with your digital account will be applied to the program, at

no added cost to you. Kroger donates annually to participating organizations based on your percentage of spending as it relates to the total spending associated with all participating Kroger Community Rewards organizations.

Note: If you are a customer, make sure you have a <u>preferred store</u> selected to view participating organizations. If you are applying on behalf of an organization, please select a store in the same area as your organization.


