Some time back, in my previous church, I was attending my annual review with the Board of Ordained Ministry to see if I was "fit" to continue as a pastor at South Bloomfield Church. This is a meeting I believe is necessary to make sure all clergy are competent and effective to shepherd a congregation. We were only granted one year at a time. I was surprised by a question that came up in that particular interview: "Floyd, how do you know when it's time?"

As I mentioned, I was caught off guard by the query and replied, "Time for what?" Is it "time" for lunch? Is it "time" for me to transfer to another church? Is it "time" for additional training or "time" for a sabbatical? As it turned out, they were asking, "How do you know when it's time to retire? Don't you get tired of what you do?"

It was not unusual for the board to come up with unusual questions, but this one was not on the radar at all. I paused to gather my thoughts, and this was my reply (as close as I can recall): "Do you mean do I tire of preaching the Word to a gathering of believers and seekers who want to know Jesus? The answer is no. Are you asking if I would rather not officiate a wedding for a man and woman who want to spend the rest of their lives together? Here again, the answer is no. If you are suggesting that I may be growing weary of going to hospitals or nursing homes to hold the hand of a loved one who is on the brink of eternity, once again, I say no. Who could tire of being with a family that desperately needs comfort because they have just been given a diagnosis of a terrible disease? Am I burned out attempting to offer assuring words to make a decision to pull a family member from a life support system?
